

Covid, autumn break and test or isolation, when you return.

If you leave Denmark in the autumn break, please be aware of the restrictions, when you return to Denmark. **This is NOT a description of other regulations and restrictions related to a travel abroad.**

Here is an abstract. First step is to read the travel restrictions relevant for you depending on your status:

I: Students, who are **vaccinated**:

Travel restrictions for people who are fully vaccinated*

Travel restrictions for people who have been fully vaccinated with an EMA-approved vaccine and who are Danish citizens or are from an EU or Schengen country, Andorra, San Marino, Monaco, the Vatican City, an OECD member state or a yellow third country.

* Includes only persons who have been vaccinated with an EMA-approved vaccine and are residents in EU and Schengen countries, OECD countries or "yellow" third countries, and Danish citizens who have been vaccinated abroad.

** Applies only to fully vaccinated from OECD countries and "yellow" third countries. Vaccinated persons from non-OECD countries must have a worthy purpose and be able to present a negative test, which has been performed no more than 48 (antigen) or 72 (PCR) hours prior to the time of entry, in order to be allowed entry into Denmark.

For this group there are no restrictions, unless you travel to red countries/regions.

II: Students, who have been infected with the virus:

Travel restrictions for people travelling who have previously been infected with COVID-19

For this group there are only restrictions, if you visit countries/regions that are red.

III: Students, who have not been vaccinated or have had the infection:

Travel restrictions for people who are not vaccinated and who have not previously been infected with COVID-19

Foreigners required to take test prior to entry to Denmark (EU Digital COVID Certificate)	Yes	Yes	Yes	Yes

If you belong to this group, you must be aware. If you travel to a yellow country, and there are many in EU, you need to be tested, when you are back in Denmark.

If you travel by plane, you must be tested at the airport. If you cross the border otherwise, you must have a test no later than 24 hours after having crossed the border.

We would like you to notify the staff (the supervisors), if you need a test upon arrival.
